

FOLM 2018 Annual Meeting

The 2018 Annual Meeting was called to order at 9:00AM, Saturday, August 18, 2018 by President AJ Theiler. A quorum was present.

A copy of the presentations are attached (size=3.01 mb). Included at the end of the presentation is a repeat of Jed Buelow excellent, in person account of his experience with EWM. This is important to remember now that our EWM is under control.

Emily Krulc, Shoreline Protection Specialist, Lincoln and Oneida Counties, gave a presentation on shoreline restoration. Emily conducted a walking tour of the rain garden in SARA Park after the meeting.

A resolution to approve the minutes from last year was moved, seconded and passed.

The treasurer report showed an average membership of 100 + from 2007 to 2017. Typically, 2018 memberships, although due January 1, will not be paid until the month of annual meeting. By tradition memberships submitted after September 1 are credited to the following year(s) unless directed by the submitter otherwise.

Changes to the grant status were minimal. The end date for the Four Year EWM effort was extended to 6/30/2020. End date for the Curley Leaf Pondweed (CLP) Rapid Response grant was extended to 12/31/2018.

There were no acres of EWM treated 2015 through 2018.

Divers hand pulled 31.25 cubic feet of Curley Leaf Pondweed (CLP) in 2018.

The committee to establish a lake district reports they have 250 signatures of the 880 signatures available of which 441 or more are required. 250 is a little over half the 441 required.

The next annual meeting will be August 17, 2019.
