Mike completed the annual accounting for 2021.

New DNR ARCGIS grant (see attached) \$5,000.00 approved. The project will focus on creating publicly available online maps to illustrate Lake Mohawksin shoreline condition and septic system status. David and Roger will work on this project with Onterra. Grant period is from 3-22 through 12-31-2024.

Offer from Tom Boisvert (Lincoln County Conservation Program Mgr.) to assist FOLM as a contact person for AIS issues, questions and connect with appropriate WDNR staff. Attend and present/discuss AIS at FOLM meetings. AIS identification training. Help coordinate the Citizens Lakes Monitoring Network (CLMN) and Clean Boats, Clean Waters (CBCL) programs. Limited AIS monitoring and control.

Prioritizing actions to begin delivery of updated Lake Management Plan:

- FOLM is looking for an individual to volunteer for setting up and managing FOLM on Facebook.

- No FOLM board members able to attend the 2022 WI Lakes Partnership Convention.

- David to update WI Lakes list with agreed contact details for himself, Connie Roger and Mike

- As acting Vice President, David will do a high-level presentation/slide show at the annual meeting. Tom Boisvert will be a presenter.

- Tom Boisvert informed FOLM that WI Headwaters Invasives Partnership (WHIP) is planning to do a purple loosertrife biocontrol on Lake Mohawksin in collaboration with WEC Energy Group. Connie has volunteered to raise galerucella beetles, with WHIP providing equipment, and release of the beetles to the lake. David to connect WHIP with Connie.

- Advertisement for FOLM stating goals, education, and contact information have been published in the 2022 WJJQ Savings and Services book.

-Coordinate survey and funding with Eddy Heath/Onterra through a possible grant application in September 2022.

-Plan to continue monitoring CLP in the future, will address if CLP areas get larger.

-Continue to monitor nonnative invasive species. Potential Survey in 2025 will determine changes.

-Adjust area where monitoring of water quality parameters are obtained to better reflect Lake Mohawksin health. This is through the WDNR Citizen's Lake Monitoring Network.

-Connie working with Healthy Lakes and Rivers Grant program. Scott VanEgeren to assist with the application processes. Two shoreland property owners have committed to participate so far.

-Loon watch over the winter months is challenging as board members are not in the state during this time. Will consider if a volunteer is found who is also a year round resident.

August Annual General Meeting - Sat August 27, 2022 from 8 to 10am . All voted for an in person meeting. Connie to contact Tomahawk City for availability of SARA Park venue.

Roger will post on web page when finalized. David will arrange for two advertisements in the Tomahawk Leader at the beginning and middle of August.

Way forward on recruiting Officers and Volunteers for FOLM - will see if folks who attend the Annual General Meeting will help out.
